

## **August 2017 Board Report**

 Landers-Loomis Field hosted the Petunia City Brass Drum & Bugle Corps Show on Wednesday night, August 2. Eight drum & bugle corps from all over the United States performed. Show organizers thanked us and commented on the district's outstanding facilities.



- As of August 4, 223 student-athletes had participated in the district's required preparticipation drug testing program. Pre-participation tests were held at the Blackhawk Center. Testing dates were Thursday, July 27 and Thursday, August 3. Again, KSB Corporate Health Services did the screenings for a charge of \$35 (up from \$30 previously). Athletes must have their pre-participation tests done prior to being able to participate in actual game competition.
- The Freshman/New Athlete Night was held on Thursday evening, August 3 from 6:30-7:30 p.m.in the OHS Gym. The event covered the requirements for participation and school attendance, eligibility, ASSIST, the extra-curricular code of conduct, use of social media, how to address concerns, equipment & supplies, training, opponents and affiliations (Big Northern/IHSA), and parent volunteer opportunities. It was repeated at Freshman Orientation on Aug. 14 for those families that could not attend the Aug. 3 date.
