All Conference selections in boys track occurred at the conference meet on May 11. Softball and baseball selections will take place May 15.

## **Spring Sports Update**

Baseball – As of May 9, the varsity baseball team is currently 2-23, and 2-16 in BNC play. They will play their 2A Regional opener on May 15 at South Beloit in a play-in game. As of May 8, the F/S team is 0-22.

Softball – The varsity softball team earned the #1 seed in the Byron Sub-Sectional and will head to Rfd. Lutheran on May 16 to open 2A Regional play. As of May 9, OHS is 17-9 overall and 12-6 in BNC play. F/S softball had a record of 2-18 (0-14 in BNC play) as of May 9.

Girls Soccer – The girls soccer team finished their inaugural regular season with a record of 4-12-1, 1-8 in conference play and played in the Byron 1A IHSA Regional the week of May 8.

Boys Track – The OHS boys finished in 3<sup>rd</sup> place out of 20 teams at this year's Hawk Classic, took 3<sup>rd</sup> place at the Ogle County Meet, and won the 1A division at the 9 team Nalley Invitational in Bolingbrook. The conference varsity meet was held on May 11 here in Oregon.

Girls Track – The OHS girls finished in second place at the Ogle County Meet, and finished in 4<sup>th</sup> of 11 teams at the Big Northern Conference Meet.

Junior High Track – The DLR JH teams competed at the Rt. 72 Conference meet at OHS on May 9 and at the IESA sectional at Winnebago on May 13.
