Fall Sports Update

Volleyball – As of October 11, the varsity volleyball team has a record of 15-5 and is in second place with a 5-1 mark in BNC games. They have earned the #4 seed of the 11 teams in the subsectional and will be playing in the Rock Falls 2A Regional on Tuesday, October 25 vs the winner of the prior day's Erie-Prophetstown vs Mendota game. The JV team is 13-9-2 overall while the fresh/soph are 10-12 overall.

Boys Golf – The varsity boys finished 6th place of 10 team at the BNC Tournament at Timber Pointe on September 21. At the IHSA Class 1A Regional, the team finished 7th of 13.

Girls Golf – At the Big Northern Tournament on September 23, the girls finished in 4th place of nine teams. Ava Hackman (4th) & Alexys Davis (11th) earned medals. At the IHSA 1A regional at Rockford, the team finished in seventh out of thirteen teams with Ava Hackman qualifying for sectional. At the Sectional, Ava advanced to the IHSA State Girls Golf Finals. At State, Ava finished in 20th place overall with a two day score of 80-79 for a 159.

Soccer – The Hawks finished the regular season with an 11-11-2 overall record. Oregon opened their 1A Regional on Wednesday, October 12 vs Winnebago here at Park West.

Football – Through Week 7, the varsity football team had a 1-6 record. Sophomores were 3-3 while the freshman were 2-4.

Cross Country – The girls finished 14th of 22 teams at the Amboy Columbus Day meet. Both boys and girls will participate at the Big Northern Conference meet in Dixon at Sauk Valley CC on Saturday, October 15..
