Spring Sports Update

Boys Track – The OHS varsity boys finished in 8^{th} of 12 teams at our annual Oregon Gebharst-Worley Invitational.

Girls Track – The OHS varsity girls took 3rd of 11 teams at the Gebhardt-Worley Invitational.

Girls Soccer – As of April 11, the OHS varsity team has a record of 3-1-1 overall and 1-0 in the Big Northern Conference.

Baseball – As of April 10, the OHS varsity baseball team currently has an overall record of 5-4 and 1-3 in Big Northern play. They have already surpassed last year's win total. This year, we have scheduled three levels in baseball for the first time in over a decade.
