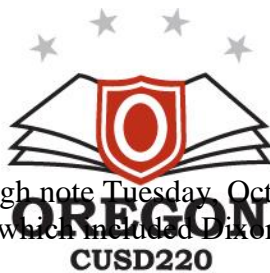

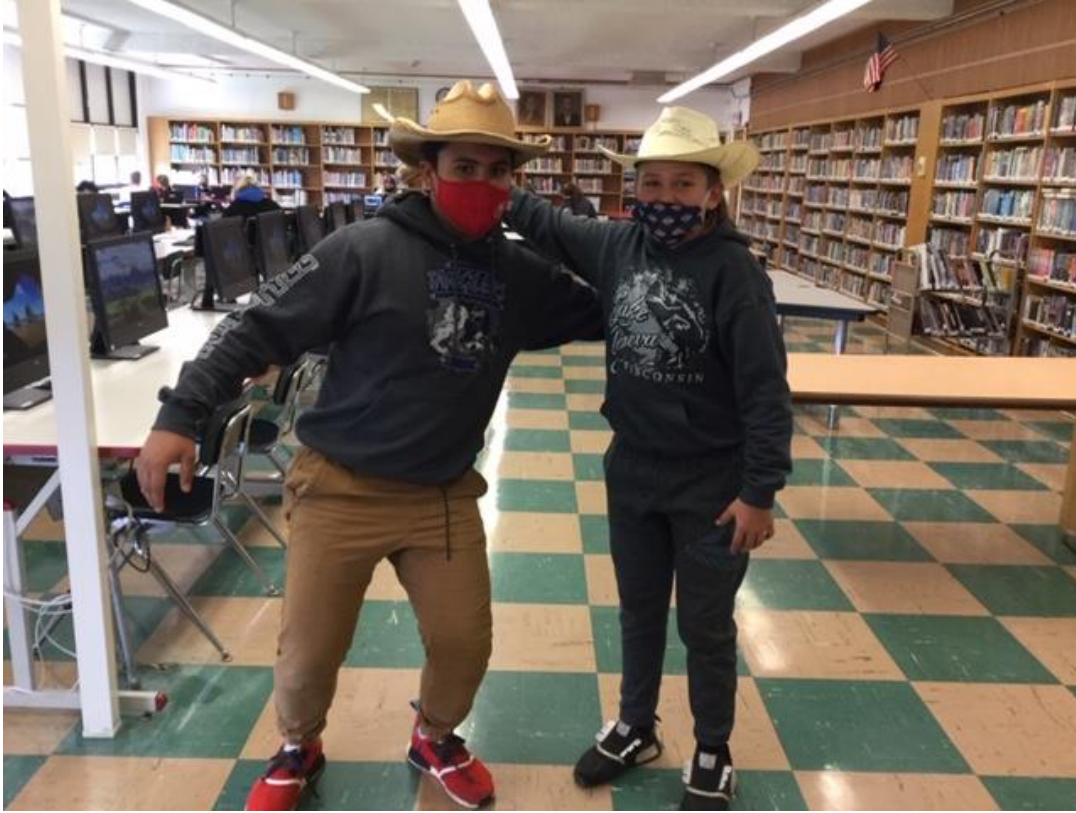


DLR students enjoyed Thursday, October 1st as a way to bring some fun to our current circumstances. Students were able to show off their favorite sports team jersey!
