2021 Summer School:

DLR began summer school (SS) with nine seventh grade and twenty eighth grade students. Students enrolled had received two or more first or second semester failures. SS was structured differently this year, preparing for a student experience we had talked about for a few years and were finally able to implement this year. The last three days of the regular school year were spent with just SS students in attendance. This allowed DLR staff to conduct a comprehensive diagnostic of what each student specifically needed with reference to learning standard deficits. The twenty nine students were split into three groups depending on their specific needs, ELA/Math/Social Studies/Science. Students would rotate through groups if they had deficiencies in several subjects. As students were able to demonstrate mastery of all deficient learning standards, they were dismissed from SS. Summer school was scheduled to run June 1st through June 24th, but all students were able to graduate out of SS by Thursday, June 17th.

New Teachers to the District/Building:

Currently we have all positions filled at DLR. While not new to the DLR, Kristen Lookingland will be moving from 7th grade ELA to 8th grade ELA this year to replace Andrew Nelson who retired. Our new 7th grade ELA teacher will be Angela Mahoney.
