
- Competitive cheer, Boys & Girls basketball and bowling just finished up; we are transitioning to boys soccer, football and volleyball now

- We celebrated National FFA week Feb 20-27 which included dress up days and various other celebrations

Academics

- We just reached the mid-point of second semester (Friday, March 5 was the end of 3rd quarter)
- We are preparing for state standardized testing (PSAT, SAT and ISA) to begin the week of April 12th
- The counselors have 95% of student scheduling completed. We will begin to build the master schedule next week and hope to finish it before Spring Break.
- Social Entrepreneurship students did the business pitches last week. We have 16 new businesses up and running. The businesses range from softball and basketball skills camps to apparel to increase awareness of mental health issues to food eating contests to support local businesses hard hit by the pandemic. We are very proud of these students and their social impact businesses.

Wednesday Intervention/Support

- We are seeing a great impact of our Wednesday intervention/support time. As of this week, we are at some of the lowest numbers of student failures.
- This data is from the 10th grade team. As you can see there are significantly fewer failures second semester





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Family Communication

- OHS Equity team met on March 3rd with students, staff and admin in attendance. This team is working on an action plan for implementation next year at OHS.
- Parent Principal Advisory met on March 2nd. There were 8 people in attendance, in person, and virtually. We had a lot of discussion about recent behavioral concerns at OHS and outcomes of Wednesday intervention/support. We also discussed end of the year plans for the seniors.
