

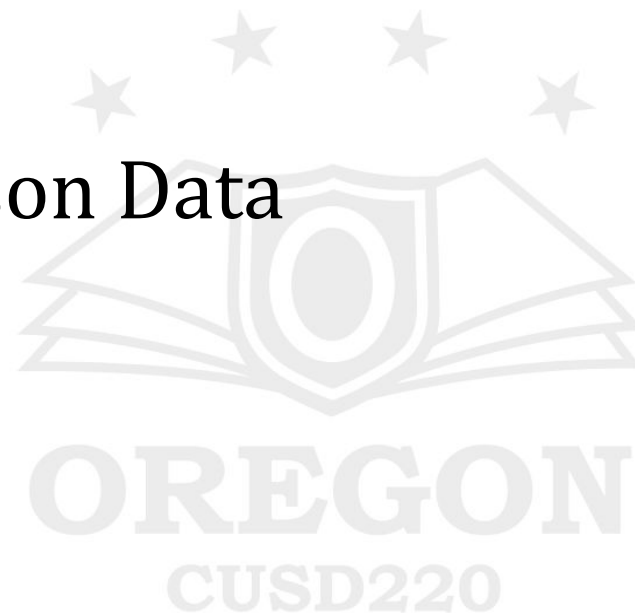

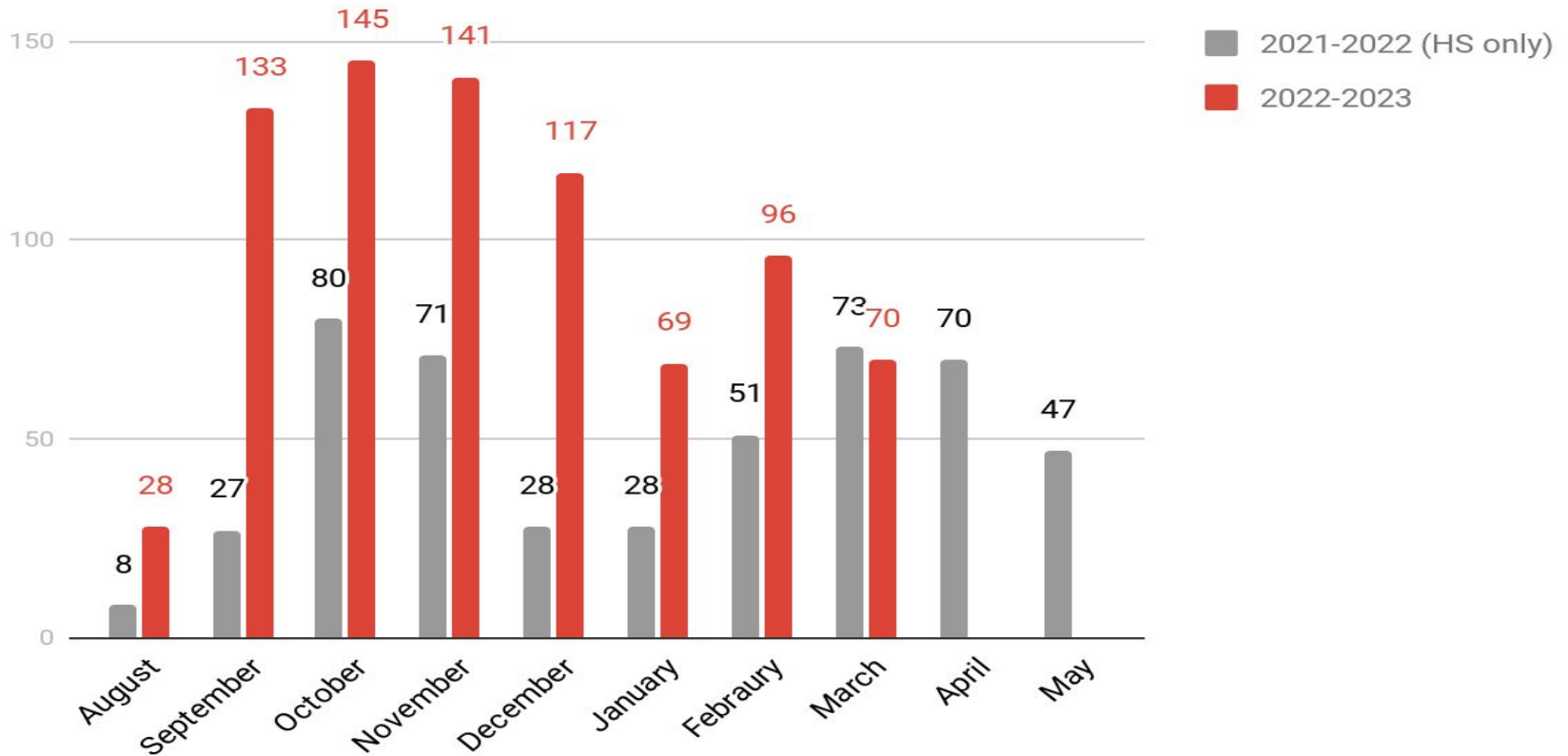

Number of detentions assigned through the month.

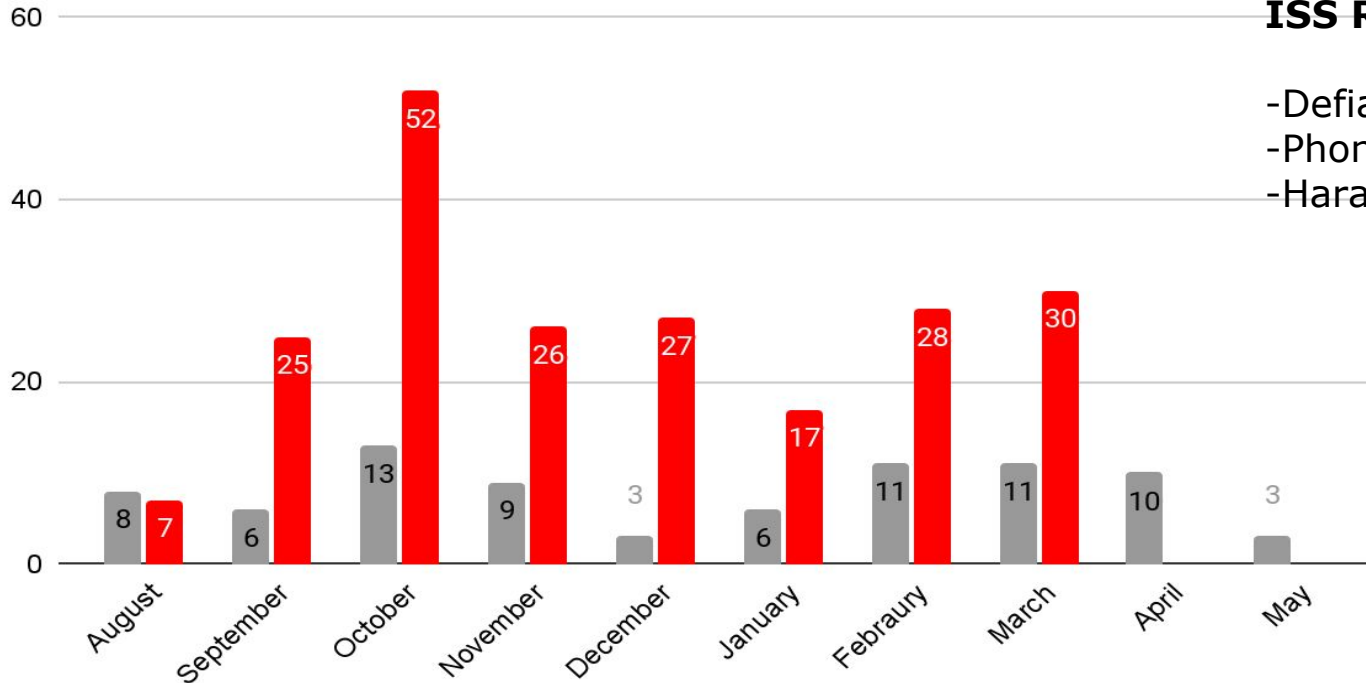

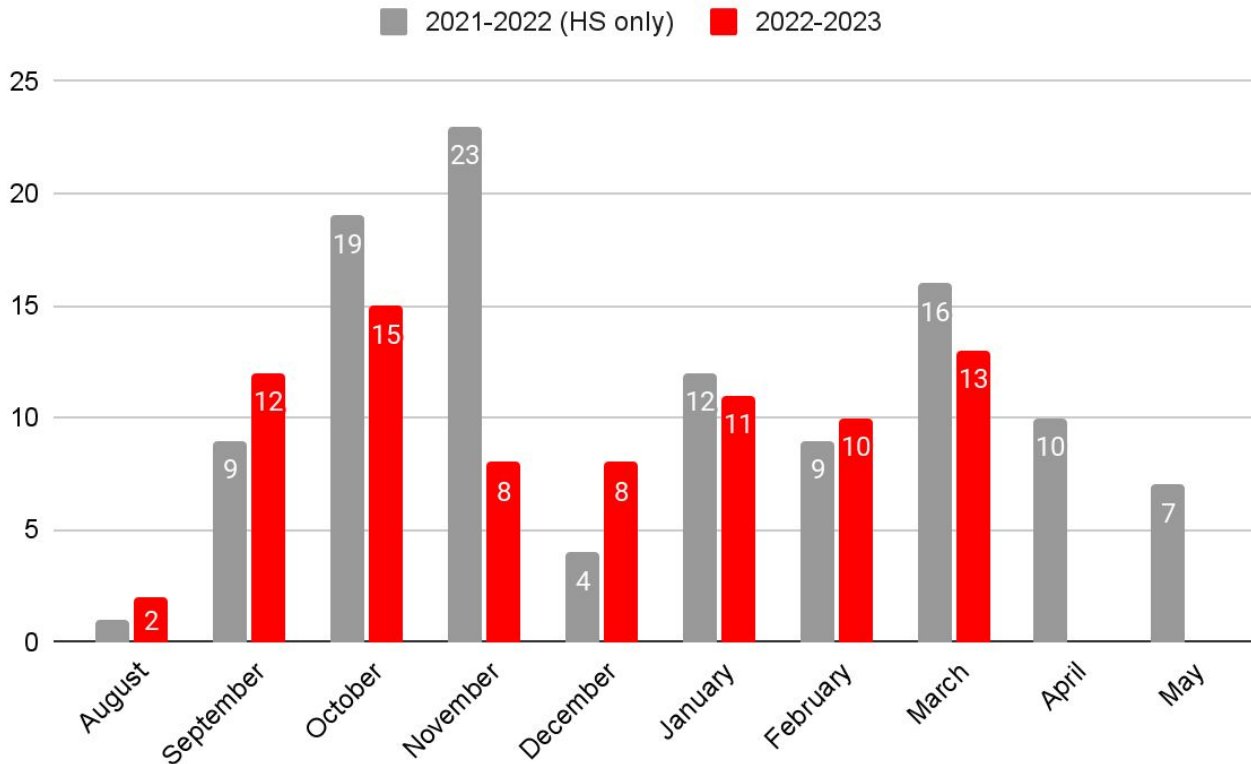
