  webinar to their building principal.


## Leader in Me:

## **Points of Interest:**



The amount of work assigned has been appropriate 124 responses







The expectations for my child during this time have been communicated clearly 122 responses

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## **Grade-level/Content Updates:**

- All grade-levels have established weekly meetings with students that are live. Various grade-levels are meeting
  multiple times with their students live during a week. Instructional times have been established to follow the ISBE
  guidelines that were presented to all schools. Special teachers have also joined in on meetings with various gradelevels and their students.
- Grade-levels are still following the BT pacing calendar to complete the year with exposure to new standards and review of ones previously taught during the year.
- Paper/pencil packets have been created for those families who do not have access to WiFi.
- Mrs. Stewart and Mr. Montanola have been reaching out to families and students who received counseling and social work during the year to provide support.
- IEP meetings have successfully occurred at OES through Zoom and phone conferences. The special education team for the building also met to discuss a timeline for EOY meetings.
- Teachers have been filling out a Google form for those students who have not been completing work. They have
  contacted the families/students. After the initial contact, Ryan and Kelli are also contacting families within 48 hours
  of getting the information in the form.
- Team meetings are occurring weekly with grade-level/content teams and administrators via Zoom.
