SIP Goals & Progress:

SIP Goal 1: DLR PARCC attainment scores for meeting and exceeding in Math and ELA will double from 2017-18 results. Measure of Academic Progress (MAP) fall testing is nearing completion which will give us data to compare with spring Partnership for Assessment of College and Career Readiness (PARCC) scores. Math reteach is also tracking student formative data

80% of DLR students will stay consistent or improve at least one PARCC attainment level on their 2019 test scores in ELA & Math as compared to their 2018 scores. MAP scores will be compared to spring PARCC scores. Winter MAP scores will be tracked as a means to monitor improvement and predict spring PARCC success.

80% of DLR students will have an increased positive outlook on school and themselves as measured from fall of 2018 to spring of 2019 through an organically developed survey. Survey being developed will be issued in late September. Positive affirmations are read twice a day and align with the four pillars of the district (Academics, Activities, Service & Leadership.)

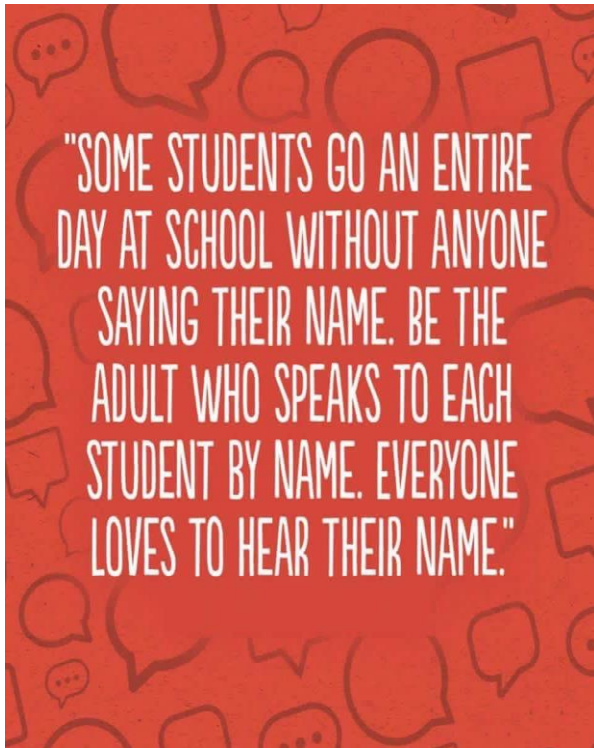
