End of Year Update

Goal I: Oregon High School students will demonstrate 5-8% growth in the percentage of students who meet/exceed SAT/PSAT benchmarks.

Update: Tentative 2019 SAT scores indicate 46% (5% decrease) met ERW; 29% (3% increase) in Math (College Board)



Goal II: 96% of Oregon High School students in the class of 2022 will be on-track at the conclusion of their freshman year.

Update: On track to meet this goal (98%); 5 students ended the year off-track; 3 of them are in summer school and will be back on track



Goal III: Overall attendance rate of 94%

Update: Goal was met; average daily attendance rate at Oregon High School was 94.7% for the year



Goal IV: Oregon High School staff will have students set a daily goal and then recite the suggested daily affirmation during the 2018-2019 school year.

Update: Students did a building-wide daily affirmation; students also created affirmations for the school as a whole that were included in the daily announcements
