### **May 2021 Monthly Report**

#### **Oregon Elementary School**

- Mrs. Stewart met with 20 students for individual sessions, these focused on social skills and emotional regulation.
- Mrs. Stewart taught 40 classroom lessons in Pre-K through 2nd grade. We finished our career unit in all levels and also played a review Kahoot game to finish the year. Thank you to Officer Kalnins for coming in to our Kindergarten classes this month.
- Mrs. Stewart facilitated 2 groups in Mrs. Costa's room this month, the topic was Bullying/Teasing/Conflict and a review lesson.
- Mrs. Stewart attended several student teaming meetings, an IEP meeting, staff meeting, LIM meeting, diversity meeting, and the district meeting.
- Mr. Montanola met with 20 students several times for individual counseling. He also taught 20 SEL/ visualizing thinking. In addition, he provided 86 individualized student work classroom interventions, and contacted 2 parents via phone call.

- Mrs. Cermak attended the Illinois School Counselor Association virtual Roundtable for middle school counselors.
- Meetings in March included IEP meetings, , 504, meetings, parent meetings, PLC, and grade level teams.
- Mrs. Cermak planned the 6th grade visit to DLR for Monday, May 17th.
- Transition meetings in May included 6 to 7, 8 to 9, Hawks Take Flight, and counseling needs transition meetings with OES and with OHS.
- Work continued on DLR master schedule and course placement.
