Academics

Summer credit recovery started on June 1 and continues until June 29. Students are using an online credit recovery program, Apex, for all classes except math. For students who needed to recover math credits, Mr. and Mrs. Reynolds are teaching two sections of math. We have 38 students in summer school, who are taking 52 classes.. Students are able to make up as many credits as needed over the summer. With two weeks left to go in summer school, students have completed 18 courses. This is great news! Unfortunately, 3 students have been dropped from summer school due to non attendance. The students who are showing up every day are having great success.

- Hiring teachers for vacancies (will make a recommendation for the English position at the July board meeting; all other positions are filled)

- Our late spring sports saw great success with girls soccer and softball going deep into the post season. Also our wrestling team enjoyed a successful season, finishing second in the conference and only losing to Dixon.

Professional Development
