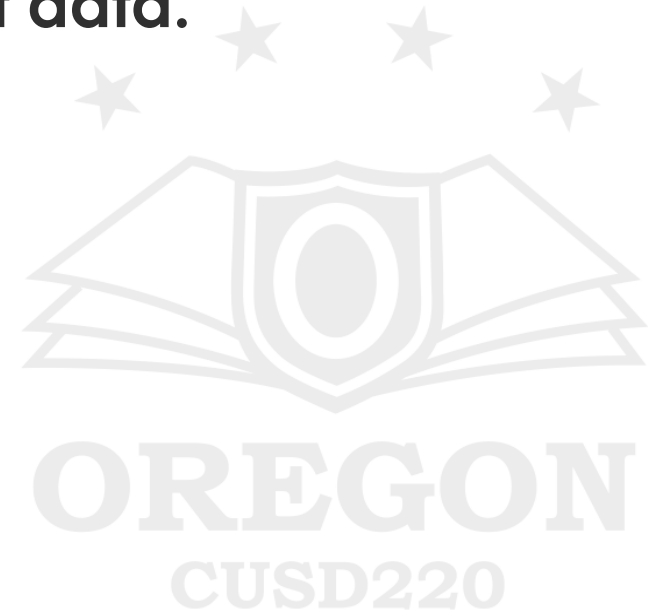

## Goal I: Reading & Math

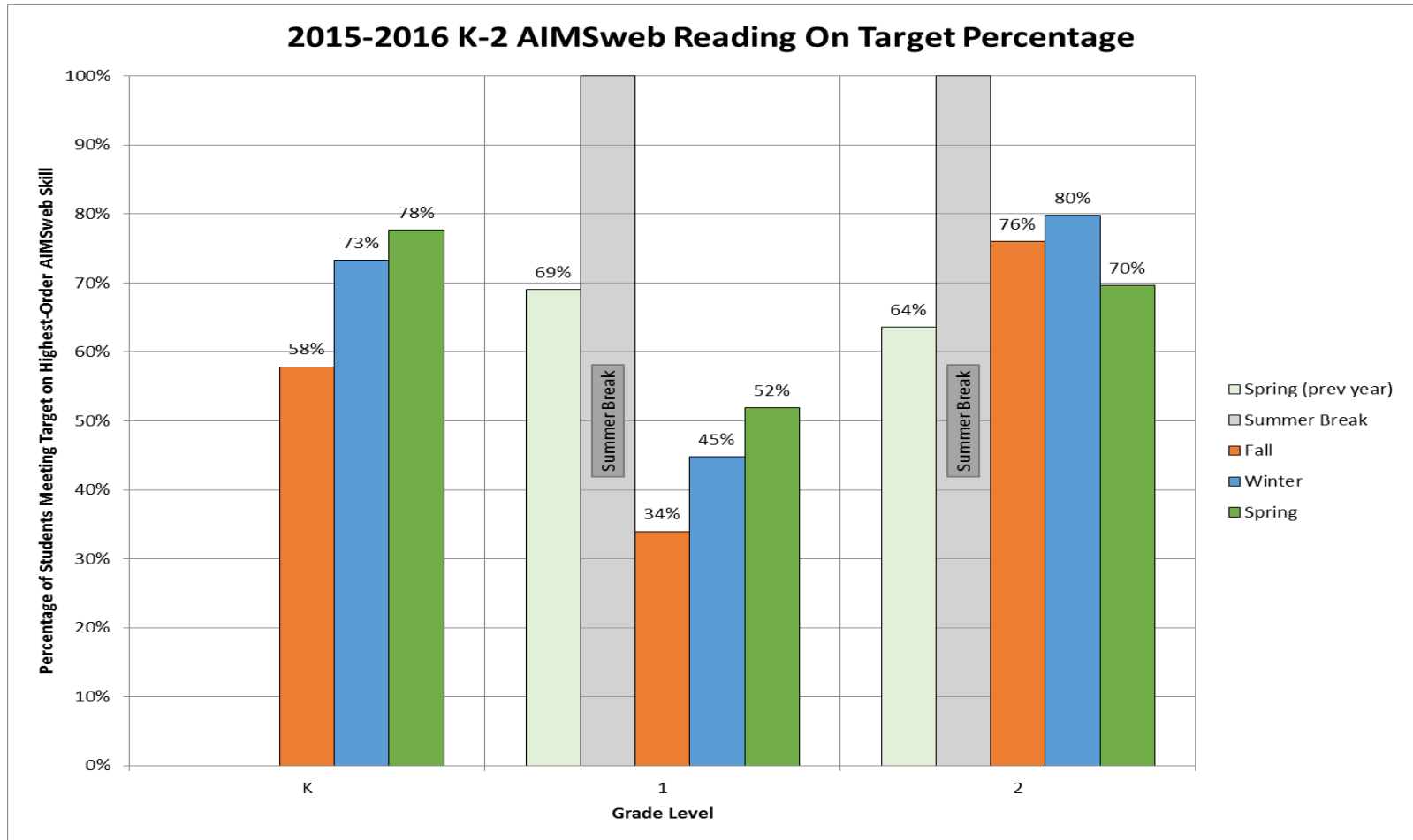
- **Student Growth: 50% of all students will achieve or surpass their positive individual student-growth target based on local assessment data.**

## Highest Order Skill: Grades K-2

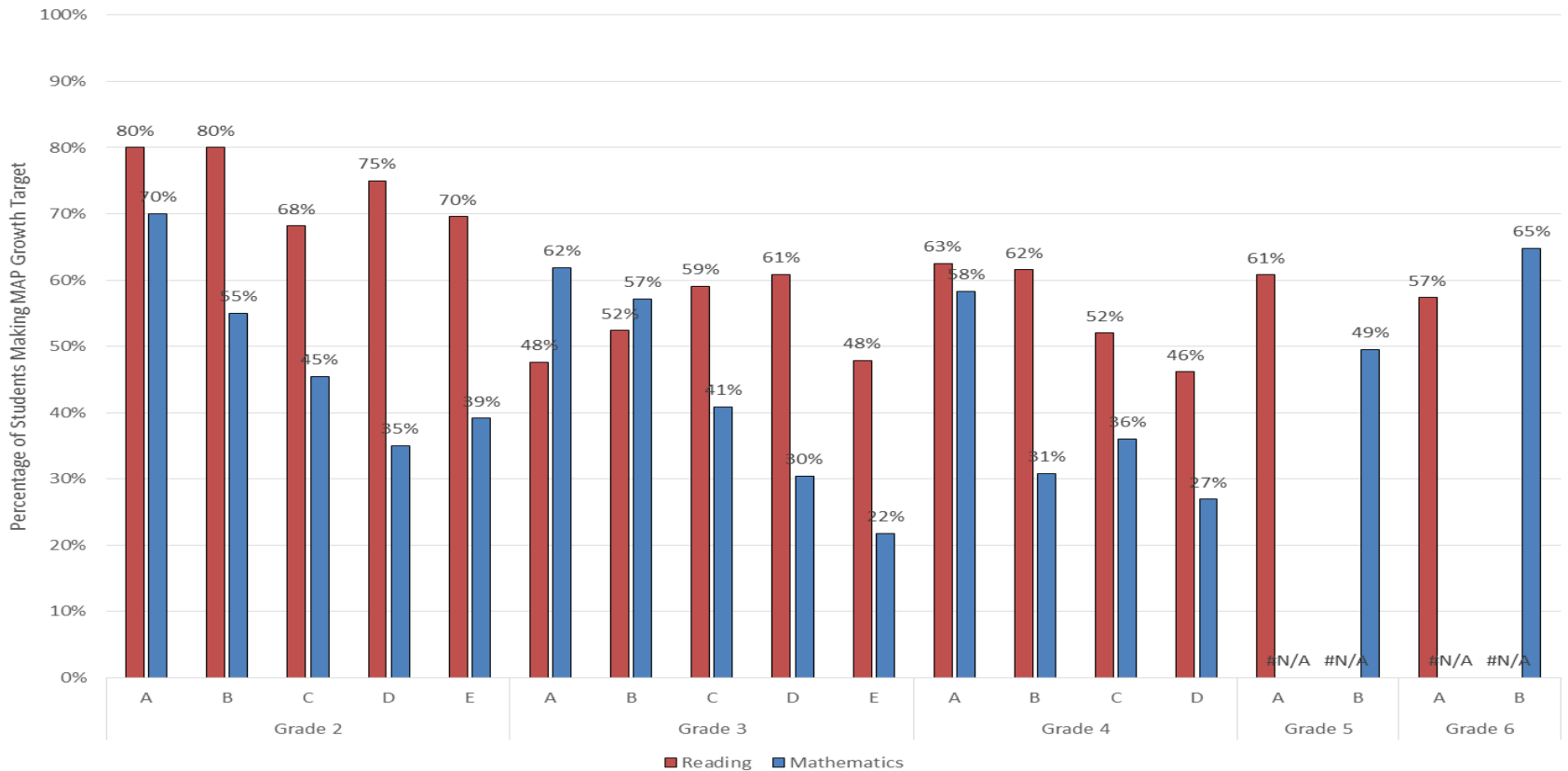

## Reading/Math: Grades 2-6

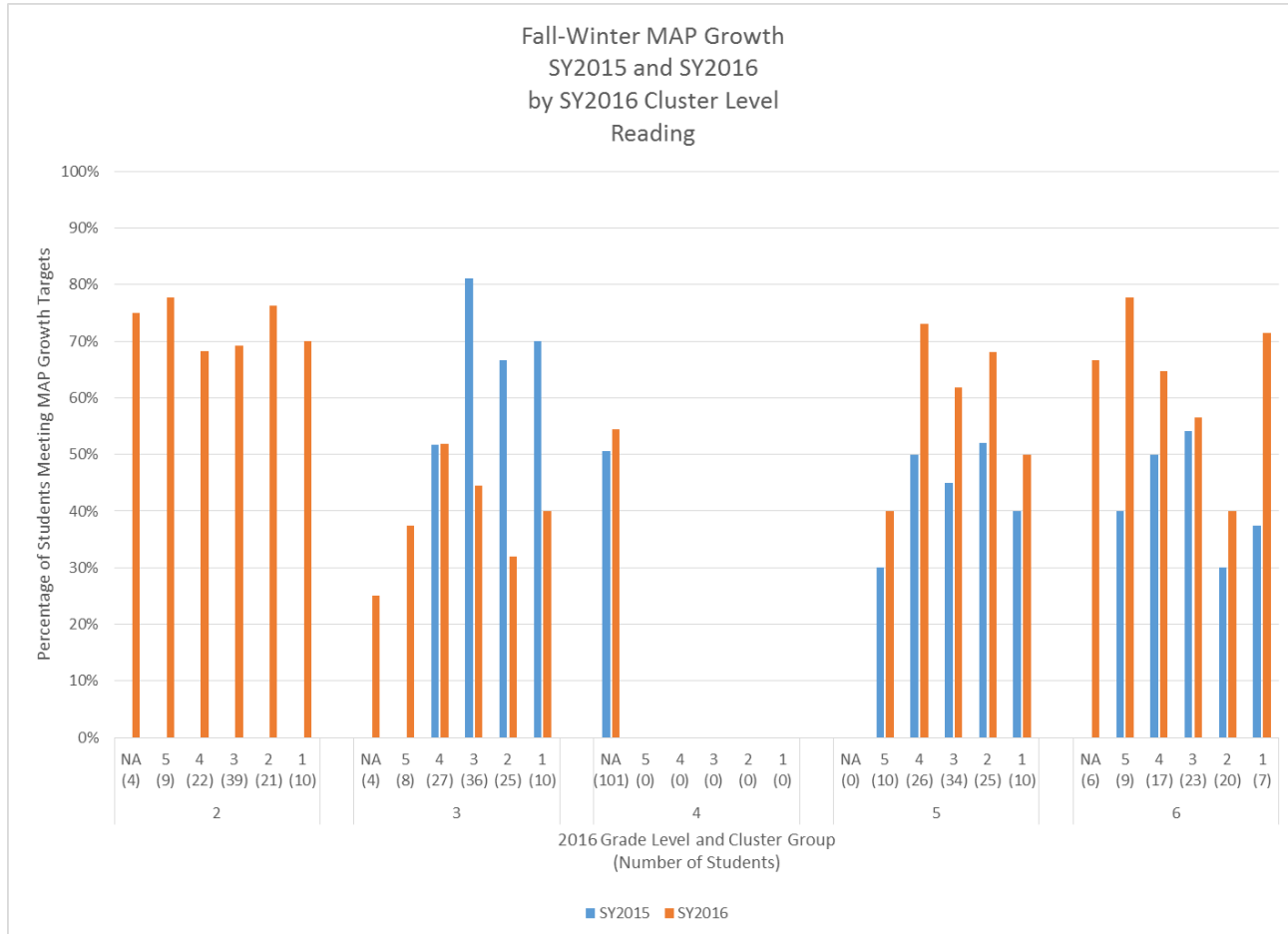
MAP Reading Growth  
Fall 2015 to Spring 2016





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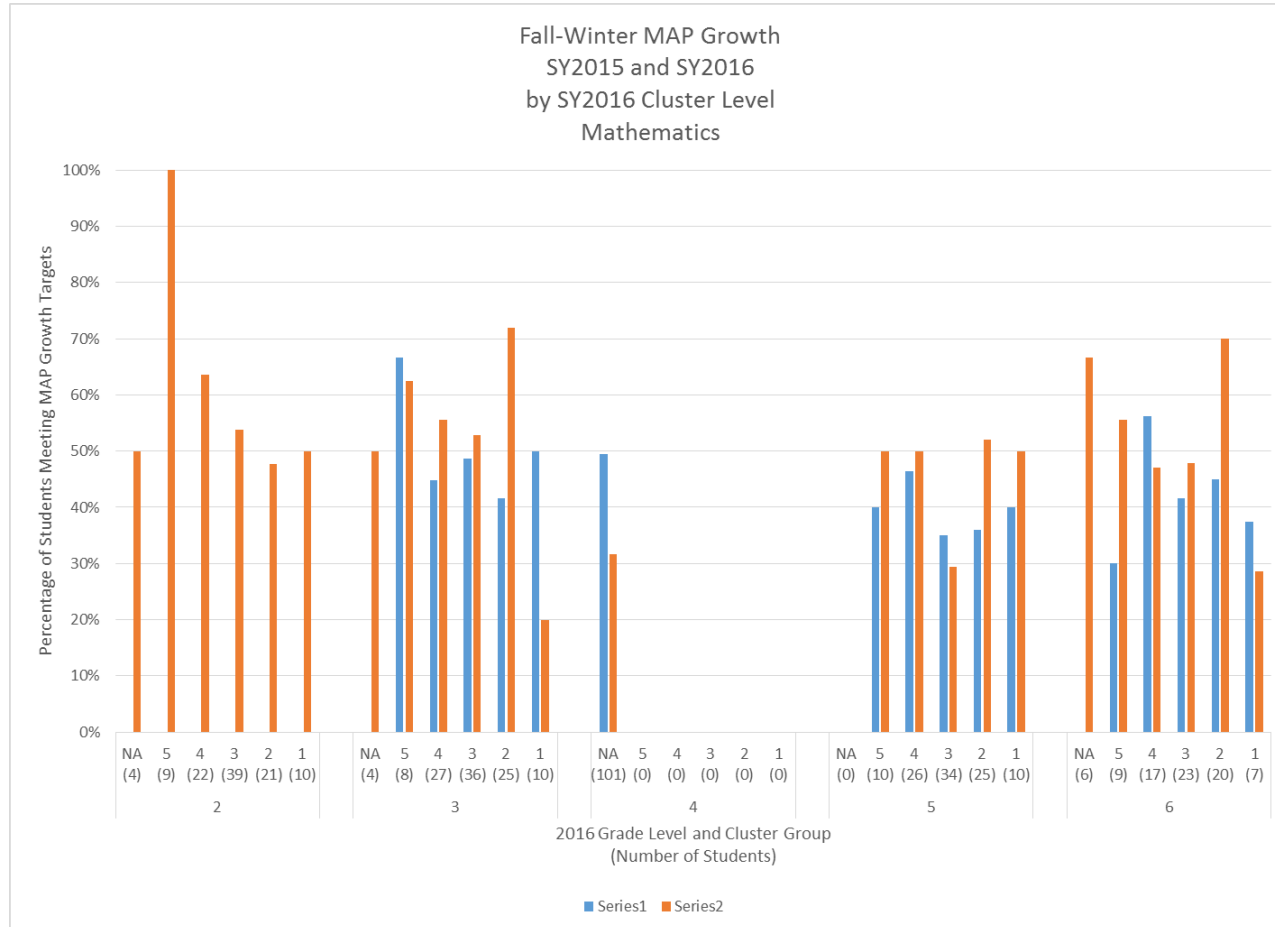
## Differentiated Grouping Data

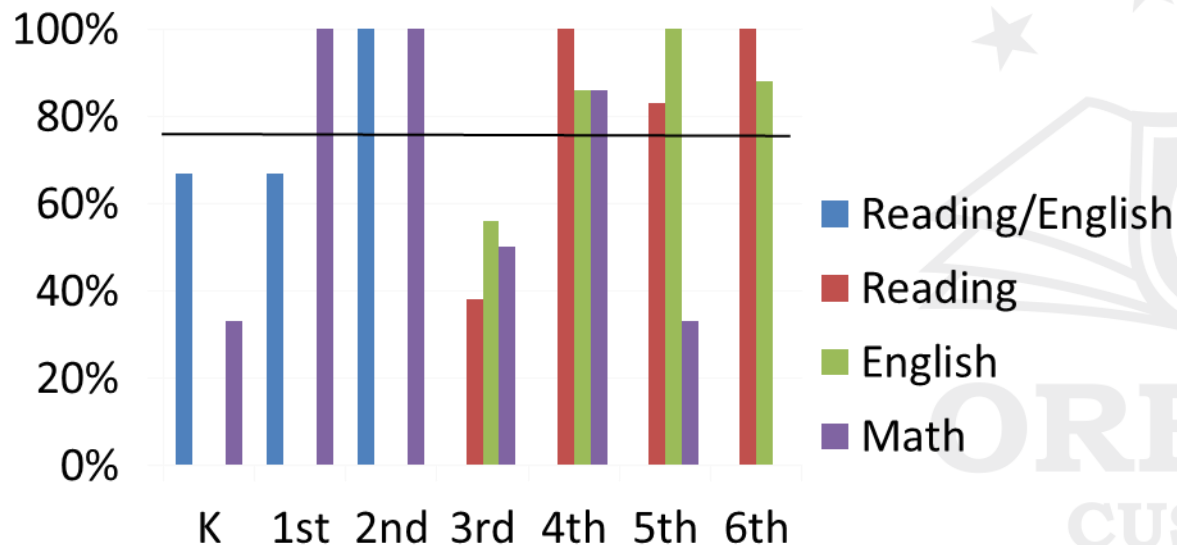

## Goal II: Special Education Inclusion

- **75% of IEP students with an IEP who do not have a speech-only eligibility and are receiving general education instruction will meet grade-level expectations within the following parameters:**
  - Powerschool report card grades of L+ or higher, C- (74%) or higher
  - Standards-based report card rating of a 2 or higher.

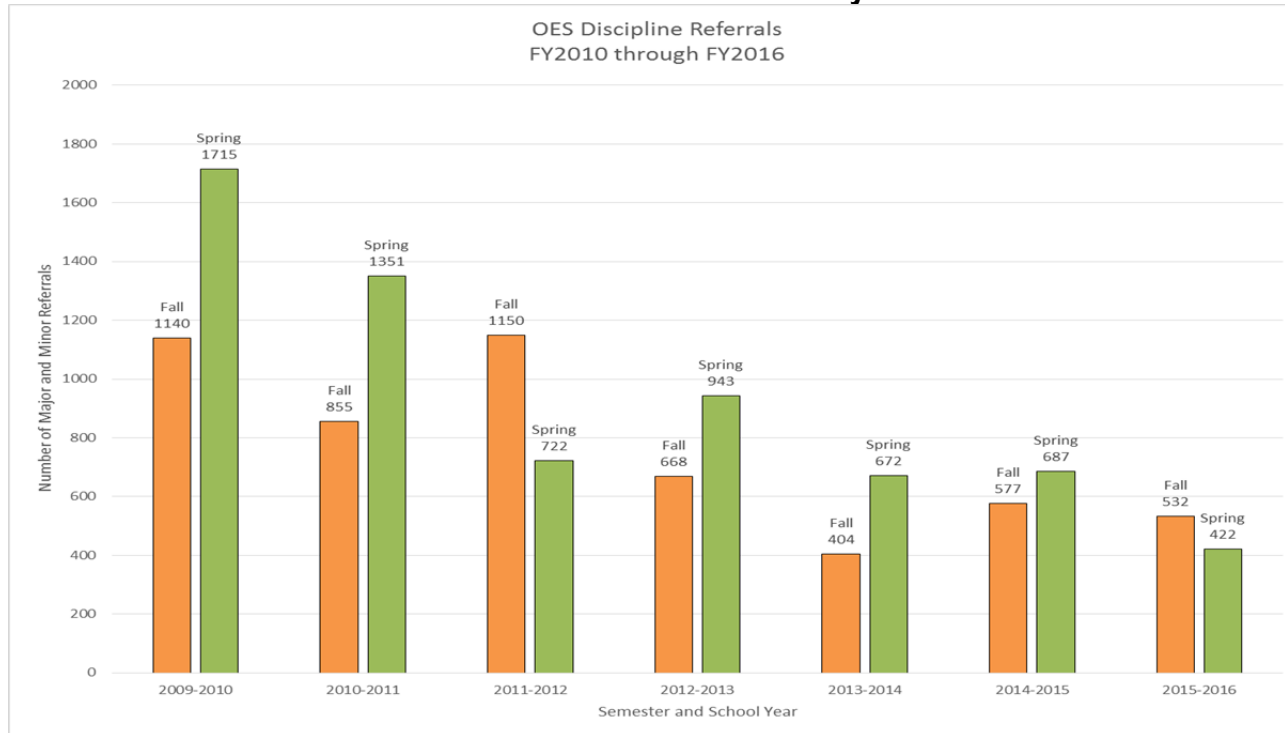

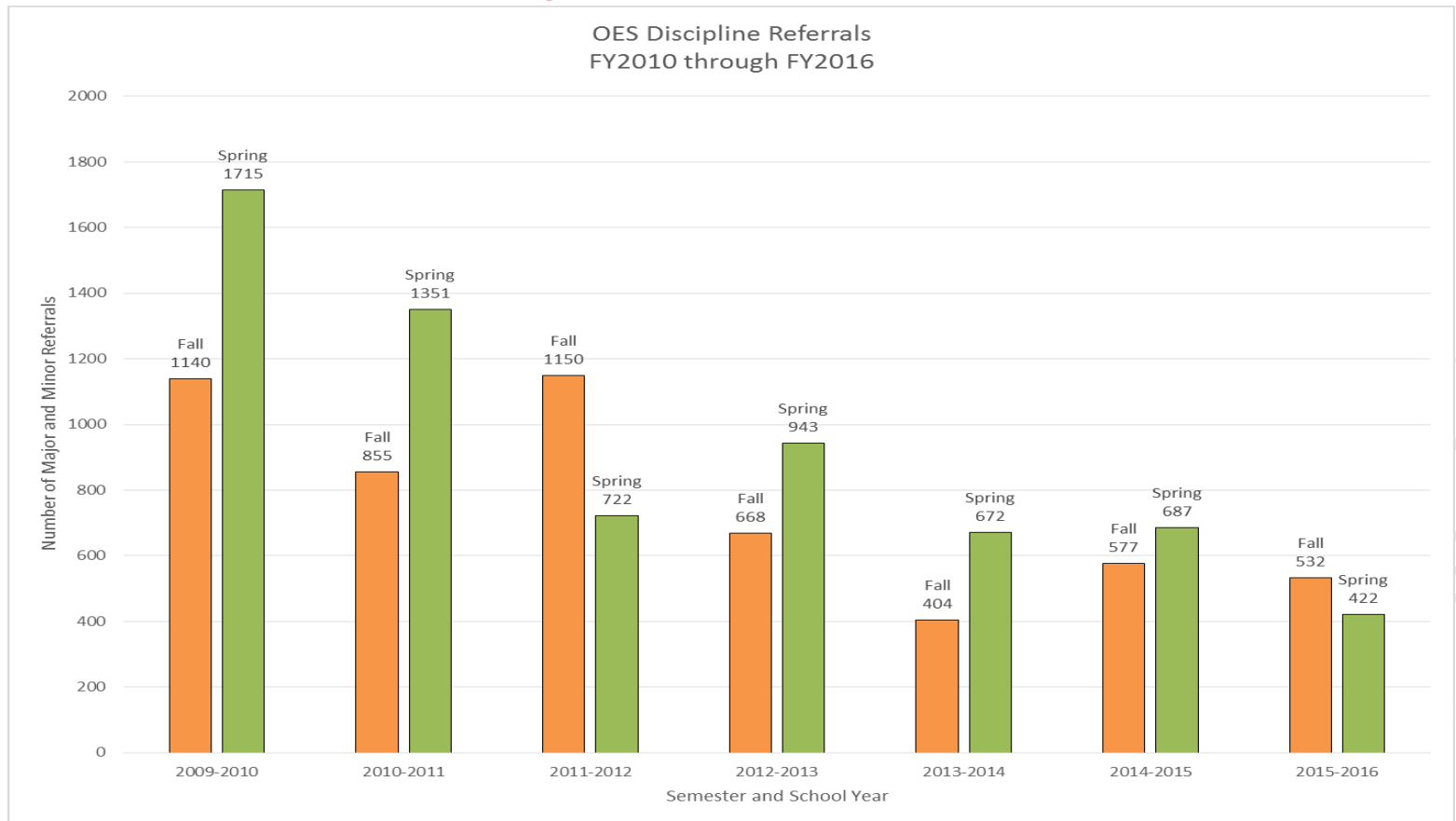

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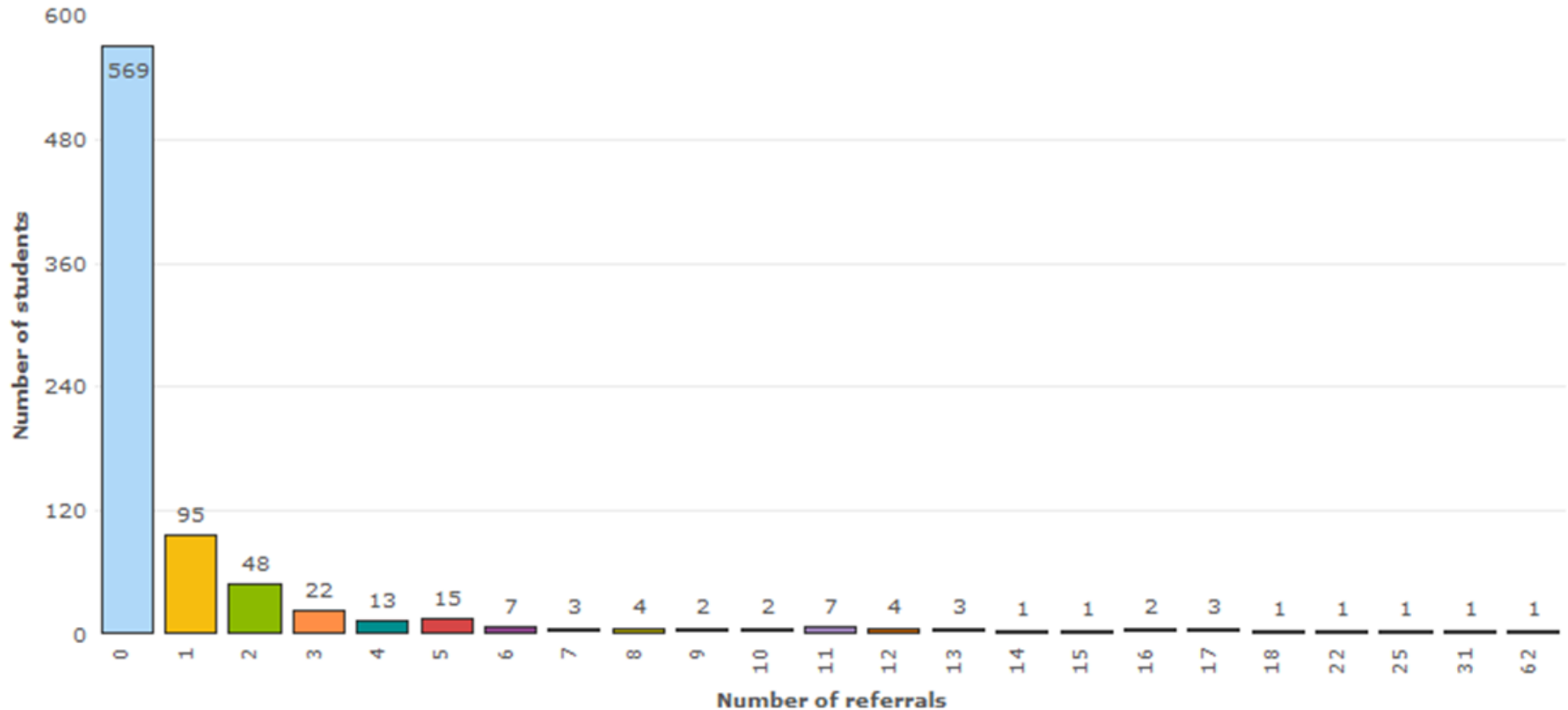
## Longitudinal View
