Athletic Leadership Council

Approximately 20 student-athletes met before school on Tuesday, November 15 for this month's Athletic Leadership Council Meeting. Topics included a recap and sharing of both highlights and struggles for the recently completed fall seasons. In addition, coping with parent pressure was also discussed.

Fall Sports

Football – The varsity football team finished the season with a 2-7 record. The sophomore squad finished 5-3 while the freshmen were 2-7.

Volleyball – The varsity volleyball finished with an overall record of 24-12 and 7-2 in BNC games, good enough for third place in the final conference standings. The JV squad was 16-10-2 overall, 7-2 in BNC games, while the F/S team was 10-18-1, 3-6 in BNC games. The varsity squad earned the #4 seed in the Regional complex and advanced to the Regional championship game where they were eliminated by top seeded Rock Falls.

Cross Country – The girls cross country team qualified for the IHSA Sectional for the first time in several seasons. At Sectional (here in Oregon), sophomore Ella Danhorn advanced to the IHSA 1A State Finals where she placed #103 out of 258 overall runners.

Girls Swimming – Senior Emily Marshall qualified for the IHSA State Finals as a member of our Byron co-op team in the 200 yd medley relay.

Jr. High Boys Basketball – Both the 7th and 8th grade teams participated at the annual Oregon Jr. High Tournament in the Blackhawk Center on Friday & Saturday, November 11 & 12. They will conclude their seasons on Dec. 6 at the annual Rt. 72 Tournament.
