MAY 2023 BOARD REPORT

Academic Updates:

- Work on the 2023-2024 Master schedule for OJSHS continues. Students will receive schedules via PowerSchool in July when the new year becomes viewable online. Requests for changes will occur in May/June and again when counselors return in July/August.
- Summer school for OJSHS is under way, starting on May 25th. Mr. Turffs serves as one of the coordinators for the high school credit recovery program.
- Mrs. Cermak and Ms. Cremeens attended a transition meeting with 6th and 7th grade teachers.
- The 8th grade and 9th grade teams met to create a list of nominees for next year's Hawks Take Flight mentoring group. Mrs. Cermak is a part of the 9th grade team and is a Hawks Take Flight mentor.
- Ms. Peterson hosted meetings related to 504 planning for students at OJSHS.



Social-Emotional Wellness Updates:

- Mrs. Stewart wrapped up all classroom lessons with a review of the year and the skills that students have learned. She also met with individual students as needed for social emotional interventions. Mrs. Stewart assisted 2nd grade with their reward trip for meeting their MAPS goals. Mrs. Stewart provided additional support wherever it was needed during the final weeks of school. She also assisted with the student portfolio presentations.
- Mrs. Stewart attended all required meetings for staff. She also attended multiple IEP meetings, intervention meetings, and grade level meetings.
- Mr. Montanola met with 20 students several times for individual counseling. He ran 17 social groups. He has met on a regular basis with 49 students including groups. In addition, he provided 60 individualized student work classroom interventions. Furthermore, he met with four parents and attended mandated meetings.
- Mrs. Cermak led a stress management group for 7th grade students. The group was created by using the Satchel Pulse system and resources.
- OJSHS Counselors and SEL Interventionist attended a Zoom meeting with Satchel Pulse to review a plan for 2023-2024 screening and how to respond to students in need of support/intervention.
- Ms. Peterson wrapped up end of the year check-in/check-out with Oregon Jr/Sr. High School.
- Ms. Peterson continued to support students experiencing peer conflict by facilitating peer mediations.

College and Career Readiness Updates:

- Counselors supported Mrs. Mowry, Registrar and the coordinator for scholarships as students were selected and plans were made for the 2023 Honors Night. This year, Honors Night occurred at the Rock River Center in Oregon where dozens of presenters attended on behalf of their awards. The format of the evening included music and a dessert table and refreshments for guests. Overall, 47 seniors were honored, and nearly \$150,000 of local scholarship money was given out.
- Counselors worked to transition students from high school to college with final transcripts for seniors.
