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### **Summer School:**

- OES had eight students who needed to attend summer school to complete their work during the e-learning time. All students but two have been attending consistently. Nine students have completed their work during the first week of summer school and do not have to attend for the remainder of the scheduled time.
- Transportation has been provided for all students. As students enter the building, their temperatures are checked and recorded. The students then wait in the hall at least six feet apart supervised by the teachers. The students are seated six feet apart in the classroom.
- Students are provided a snack by the school.

### **Professional Work:**

- The kindergarten and first grade teams have met this summer to look at their Beyond Textbook pacing calendars to revise the standards and when they are assessed.
- Grade-level teams also communicated with each other on where their students ended the year with various skills in order for the next grade-level to plan accordingly with their calendars.
- Beth Taylor, special education teacher, participated in courses that cover the topic of Autism. She shared her notes and take-aways with all of the teachers at OES. This was greatly appreciated.
- Ryan and Kelli met with the ST Math representative on the first stages of implementing this resource with kindergarten and first grade students which promotes a growth mindset with learning math.

### **2020-2021 students:**

- The kindergarten team met with Kelli via Zoom to discuss plans for incoming kindergarten students and gaining "screening information" from their pre-k experience.
- A Google Form was created and sent to the area pre-k teachers, OES, Nash, Best Beginnings, & Head Start to gain this information. The kindergarten team will create class lists based off of this information. The original schedule of meeting individually with families and students will occur on August 13th and 14th with the students attending on August 17th.
- Families will be notified before August 1st via letter, Facebook, and the website about this information.
- A video will be created by Ryan and Kelli for new families to the building (new kindergarten/new to district) that is a "walking tour" of the school along and provide the Power Points from the kindergarten orientation and new family orientation nights to families via email and the website.



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
