- 5 hour school day (10-3:00)
 - Students will have all classes, just shortened class periods
 - Passing periods will be controlled with social distancing and shortened time
- Everyone in the building (students, staff and any visitors) wears a mask
- Students are self-certified regarding symptoms
- Quarantine room is available



- Lunches broken down into groups of less than 50; lunches will be grab and go
- Time from 8:00-10:00 AM will be used by staff to prep for students who are eLearning, meet in professional learning communities and provide intervention to students who have skill gaps from
- Locker rooms will not be used for PE; PE will have alternate assignments until we go to full days of school
- Classrooms will be cleaned during teacher plan periods as much as possible



- Start of the year will focus on transition back to school, identified skill gap areas, social emotional learning and the Leader in Me
- Teachers will be working to integrate Chromebooks to the greatest extent possible, in preparation for possible move to 100% eLearning
- Grading will be done as usual; there is no "do no harm" clause
- We will continue to work within the IHSA guidelines for return-to-play
