Spring Sports Update

Softball – As of May 9, the varsity softball team has a 15-10 overall record, including an 8-6 mark in conference games. The team will open IHSA Class 2A Regional play on Tuesday, May 16 here at Park West vs Winnebago.

Baseball – As of May 9, the OHS baseball team has a 13-11 overall record, its' best record in a decade. The team is 5-10 in Big Northern conference games. The team will open up IHSA Class 2A Regional play on Mon. May 16 here in Oregon vs Mendota.

Girls Soccer – As of May 9, the girls' soccer team has an overall record of 10-5-2. They finished with a 4-4 Big Northern conference record. OHS opened the IHSA 1A Regional vs Genoa-Kingston at Indian Creek on Wed. May 10

Boys Track – The OHS boys finished in 3rd place of five teams at annual Ogle County Meet in Rochelle on May 2. They finished in 6th place out of nine at the Carlin Nalley Invitational in Lisle on May 6. The team will participate in the Big Northern Conference Meet at Rock Falls on May 11.

Girls Track – The OHS girls track team had an outstanding performance in taking second place at the Big Northern Conference meet here in Oregon on May 4. OHS had two conference champs, Hadley Lutz in the long jump and Sonya Plescia in the pole vault. OHS will compete at the IHSA Sectional at Winnebago on May 12.

Junior High Track – Our 7th grade boys & girls combined team won the annual Oregon Jr. High Carnival Relays on May 1. All grades competed at the Rt. 72 Conference meet in Winnebago on May 9. Results were not available at the time of this write-up. The teams will participate at the IESA Sectional at Orion on Saturday, May 13. If we have qualifiers from that meet, they will move on to the Jr. High State Meet in East Peoria May 19 & 20.
