## **Celebrations:**

Achieving recognition on the US News & World Report's Best Schools List is a testament to the hard work, commitment, and passion of our entire school community. We are ranked 201 of 1,292 schools in Illinois. We are in the top 20% in our state and in the top 40% in the nation. We earned this recognition through our student performance on statewide testing (SAT), number or students taking an Advanced Placement (AP) and passing the AP test and our graduation rate. This accomplishment would not have been possible without the unwavering support of our parents, the diligence of our students, and the expertise of our educators. It reflects our shared commitment to providing a high-quality education that empowers our students to excel academically and personally. (See more information in the addendum to this report).

<u>New this Year:</u> We have introduced an additional student recognition program called "Hawk Hero" this year. Any staff member can nominate a student, at any point, for the good things they are doing. So far this year, we have had 26 student nominations. We are currently working on benchmarking assessments across our entire building. Students have taken the following benchmark assessments:

- MAP provides data for 7th-8th grades on Reading, Writing and Math
- ThinkCerca provides data from 7-11<sup>th</sup> grade students on Writing
- iXL provides data for 7-11<sup>th</sup> grades students on Math; 7-8<sup>th</sup> grade students on ELA
- PSAT/SAT formatives provides data for 9-11<sup>th</sup> grades on areas for improvement on spring standardized tests

You can see many scores and various data points in the School Improvement Plan. Please let me know if you have questions.

### **Culture**:

Some things we are doing to continue to refine our culture and influence our positive climate:

- Hawk Hero (sited above) we are also doing it for teachers, as requested by our executive student council leaders

## **Athletic Action Plan:**


- We have a working draft of the updated version of the Athletic Action Plan DRAFT Athletic Action Plan


