#### **Current Enrollment:**

Pre-Kinder - 38 7<sup>th</sup> Grade - 116 8<sup>th</sup> Grade - 113

### School Improvement Plan (SIP) Goals & Progress:

SIP Goal 1: DLR PARCC attainment scores for meeting and exceeding in Math and ELA will double from 2017-18 results. We are currently awaiting IAR results to compare to prior year results. Math numbers will be of particular interest as that is where our reteach efforts were directed this year.

80% of DLR students will stay consistent or improve at least one PARCC attainment level on their 2019 test scores in ELA & Math as compared to their 2018 scores. No new updates.

80% of DLR students will have a positive outlook on school and themselves as measured by a fall of 2018 and spring of 2019 organically developed survey. Spring survey is being administered this week after which we will compare results to the fall survey.

**PPAC:** - Meeting was held on Thursday, April 24th.

- District strategic planning work regarding activities was discussed.
- Suggestion to hold a separate parent meeting for JH athletics instead of on Meet the Teacher Night
- It was discussed athletic expectations, the 5 tenants, should be reinforced with JH coaches and athletes
- Discussed the suggestion of having online registration fees all in one place

### **Professional Development:**

5/29 – 6/3 – Two days of Google training followed by two days of The Leader in Me training.

DLR teachers are required to make an instructional round with another teacher, including a follow up meeting, once during 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarters.

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
