Spring Sports Update

Baseball – The OHS baseball team lost its' Regional opener to Fulton 11-10 and finished the season with a 3-23 record.

Softball – The varsity softball team finished their season on May 13 dropping their Regional opener to Byron 6-5. The team finished with a 6-22 overall record, 5-15 in BNC play.

Girls Soccer – The girls' soccer team has had a tremendous season, winning their first Regional Championship since the inception of the program in 2017 – a 3-2 win over Byron in overtime.

Heading into the Sectional matchup on May 15, the team had an overall record of 15-6-1, 5-3 in Big Northern games.

Boys Track – The OHS boys finished in 5rd place at the Big Northern Conference Meet in Byron on May 9. They participated in the Lena-Winslow Sectional on May 17.

Girls Track – The OHS girls made history by winning their first ever Big Northern Conference Championship on May 2. A week later, the team finished in second place of 17 at the IHSA 1A Sectional. Numerous OHS athletes qualified for the state meet including both the 4x100 and 4x200 relay teams along with Abigail Hopkins (hurdles/triple jump), Cynthia Nyderek (hurdles/triple jump), Brenna Noon (shot put), Janae Bothe (shot put), Lydia Cermak (long jump) and Lyndi Kenney (pole vault).

Junior High Track – The DLR JH teams competed at the Rt. 72 Conference meet at Winnebago on May 7. The 8th grade girls were conference champions while the boys were runner up. The 7th grade girls and boys finished 4th and 6th respectively. The teams then travelled to Sterling on May 11 to participate in the IESA sectional where the 8th grade girls also earned a 1st place finish. There were multiple boys and girls along with several relay teams that qualified for the Jr. State Meet in East Peoria May 17 & 18.
