Spring Sports Update

With the historically awful spring weather, a shortage of officials, and a bus driver shortage, getting games and meets in these last eight weeks has been challenging to say the least. Thanks are in order

for athletes and coaches who have had to overcome these obstacles this spring through no fault of their own.

Softball – As of May 9, the varsity softball team has a fine 20-8 overall record, including a 12-5 mark in conference games (currently good for 3rd place). The team will open IHSA Class 2A Regional play on Wed. May 18 at Rock Falls vs Byron.

Baseball – As of May 9, the OHS baseball team has a 4-20 overall record. The team will open up IHSA Class 2A Regional play on Mon. May 16 at Rock Falls.

Girls Soccer – As of May 9, the girls' soccer team has an overall record of 9-8-2. They finished with a 4-4 Big Northern conference record. OHS opened the IHSA 1A Regional vs Genoa-Kingston at Princeton on Tues. May 10

Boys Track – The OHS boys finished in 3rd place of nine teams at the Forreston Relays in late April and 12th of 19 at our own Carlson/Hawk Classic on April 29. Senior Daniel Dominguez is currently ranked at #5 in Class 1A in the discus.

Girls Track – The OHS girls track team took 4^{th} place at the Big Northern Conference meet on May 4. Senior Jenae Bothe is currently ranked #1 in Class 1A in the shot put and #4 in the discus.

Junior High Track – The DLR JH teams competed at the Rt. 72 Conference meet here in Oregon on May 12. Results were not available at the time of this writeup. We have an entirely new group of jr. high track coaches this spring. Matt Hussung, Gabe Poser, Angela Mahoney, and Liz Grogan have stepped in and kept our program running smoothly. The teams will participate at the IESA Sectional at Stillman Valley on Saturday, May 14. If we have qualifiers from that meet, they will move on to the Jr. High State Meet in East Peoria May 20 & 21.
