<u>Math/Science PLC</u> – With Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) testing in full swing; we are encouraging the students to do their best. According to winter MAP testing scores, 8% of seventh graders are predicted to meet or exceed on IAR testing and 13% of eighth graders.

<u>SS/ELA PLC</u> – In reading, according to winter MAP testing scores, 20% of seventh graders are expected to meet or exceed on IAR testing and 23% of eighth graders.

<u>SEL PLC</u> –Community service projects in Mount Morris are a go!! Students not required to attend school on Wednesdays for interventions are now able to sign up for all day service projects. Our committee finalized plans with the city to perform works at parks to help get them ready for spring and summer use.









