School Improvement Plan (SIP) Goals & Progress:

<u>SIP Goal 1: DLR PARCC attainment scores for meeting and exceeding in Math and ELA will</u> <u>double from 2017-18 results.</u> Practice opportunities are being taken advantage of in preparation for this year's Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) which takes the place of PARCC test that had been given the past several years.

80% of DLR students will stay consistent or improve at least one PARCC attainment level on their 2019 test scores in ELA & Math as compared to their 2018 scores. No new updates.

80% of DLR students will have a positive outlook on school and themselves as measured by a fall of 2018 and spring of 2019 organically developed survey. Spring survey will be administered later in April and results from fall and spring will be compared.


