#### School Improvement Goal 1 SAT score improvement

- Continued work on rigorous instructional methods
  - ICLE consultant visited math classes and met with math teachers to discuss planning for and incorporating rigorous instructional methods
  - Math teachers also worked with students on tier 2 interventions for students who needed specific skill building during study halls. It was very focused instruction with small groups of students.

#### Three tier SAT prep from Jan-April

- Tier 1: In class prep integrated with content
- English department worked all year on developing and administering common assessments to determine student growth in the area of weakness for our students
- Adam Larsen worked with us to gather data and put it into a dashboard that is easy for teachers to analyze and focus on particular students
