## **Athletic Leadership Council**

Approximately 25 student-athletes met after school on Wednesday, November 8 for this month's Athletic Leadership Council Meeting. Topics included the Leader In Me concept of "beginning with the end in mind" as athletes begin their winter sports seasons. Also covered was key characteristics of high functioning and low functioning teams. On Monday, November 13, Coach Reynolds took six athletes to East Peoria for the IHSA Student-Athlete Leadership Council.
