### **Spring Sports Update**

Softball – The varsity softball team saw their season end with a first round Regional loss to Genoa-Kingston. The squad finished with a 17-13 overall record. The JV team went 11-11.

Baseball – The varsity baseball team saw their season end with a first round Regional loss to Mendota. The squad finished with an 11-18 overall record. The JV team finished 7-13-2.

Girls Soccer – The girls soccer team has had the best season in the history of the program, winning the IHSA Regional on May 14 and upping their overall record to 18-1 as of that date.



Boys Track – The OHS boys finished in 4th place of ten schools at the annual Big Northern Conference Meet in Dixon on May 9. The team will participate in the IHSA 1 Sectional at Winnebago on Friday, May 17.
