Summer School: Summer school will be held at OJSHS May 29-31, June 3-14 from 8:30-11:30. There are three sessions of summer school:

1. Credit recovery - high school students who need to recover credits of classes that they failed. This will be done using APEX, our online credit recovery program.
2. Remediation/skill building- junior high students who need to work on building their skills in the core classes. This will be done using the curriculum and skill building resources that we have available (iXL, ThinkCerca)
3. Math Academy - This is for students who could advance in the math sequence. They will work with Mr. and Mrs. Reynolds to build/solidify their math skills.

Student Activities

- On May 8 (May 10 is the rain date), we joined the City of Oregon, Oregon Police Department and Oregon Fire Department to hold a “Ride & Roll” to school day. It was a lot of fun. - We wrapped up all standardized testing and started to get some initial results. We are cautiously optimistic.
- HS teachers have completed ThinkCerca. We will receive results before the end of the school year.

The Leader in Me - The entire district will be receiving training from our Leader in Me coach, Kelli White on May 28, 2024. Teachers and administrators will be part of the “blue” training. This training helps teachers to understand ways to integrate the 7 Habits of Highly Successful People and the 4 Disciplines of Execution into the classroom. Kelli will also be working with our student Lighthouse team and our adult Lighthouse team on July 25th to help us analyze our Measurable Results Assessment (MRA) and plan some goals for the 2024-2025 school year. We are very proud that our Student Lighthouse team planned and created a student mentoring program to be implemented in the 2024-25 school year.
