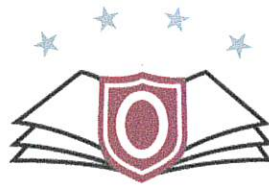

Dear Mr Lawton, Dr Mahoney, and Oregon Community Unit School District 220,


