School Improvement Plan:

The OJSHS School Improvement team worked this summer to develop the school improvement plan for the year. It was determined that our goals would be:

1. Increased students outcomes: 3-5% increase in students meeting/exceeding the benchmark on IAR and at least meeting the state average on ACT
2. College/Career/Life Readiness: All 7-9th grade students will complete a student portfolio that is aligned with the Profile of a Graduate
3. Instructional leadership will be provided by the administrative team and instructional coach weekly.

Next Steps: The next steps for our plan is to determine the baseline data (once school starts) and set benchmarks for each of the goals.

We will share the link to the School Improvement Plan when the department goals are added.

Theater Project Update:

The new seats have been installed and look really good. We are waiting for the nameplates of the donors that will be installed on the seats when they arrive. The vendor said that they should be done on August 23. Our new custom folding chairs will be arriving around September 20. We will be distributing the old seats to our donors as soon as possible. We are tentatively planning an open house for the community over Autumn on Parade weekend.

Starting the School Year

We are excited and looking forward to the 2024-25 school year. This year, we have added two new Advanced Placement (AP) classes, three new dual credit classes, a new high-interest science class (Forensics) and two new “life ready” courses that were student requests (Senior Seminar - focusing on financial literacy and Foods & Nutrition). We are excited to continue our forward progress that has lead us to increased student outcomes. We are 99% staffed with some excellent new hires. We are very proud of how clean the building is and how beautiful our grounds look.
